Second Paloma is a Los Angeles-based glam indie pop band making music that's equal parts moody, melodic, and irresistibly danceable. Built around bass-driven grooves, dual-lead vocals, and sharp songwriting, the six-piece blends shimmering indie pop with alternative rock energy, creating songs that feel theatrical without losing their emotional core.

The band officially formed in 2025 after years of collaboration between its members in various Southern California projects dating back to 2015. That history gives Second Paloma an uncommon chemistry, balancing polished arrangements with the spontaneity of a live band.

Drawing inspiration from David Bowie, Blonde Redhead, Lady Gaga, and Portugal. The Man, Second Paloma occupies a space between art rock and modern indie pop. Their songs shift from intimate moments to explosive choruses, combining soaring harmonies with infectious rhythms and a playful sense of drama.

The lineup features Alex Yeomanson (lead vocals, rhythm guitar), Mia Licon (lead vocals), Howie Fitzgerald (bass), Asher Leibgold (guitar), Arifa Khursheed (keyboards), and Aabid Fitzgerald (drums).

Their debut single, Camera, introduced the band's cinematic production, layered vocal arrangements, and hook-driven songwriting. Their newest single, This Shade of Yellow, expands that foundation with dynamic tempo changes, expansive arrangements, and a confident indie-rock swagger.

Whether performing live or crafting ambitious recordings in the studio, Second Paloma embraces contrast - melancholy and celebration, polish and chaos, vulnerability and swagger - creating music that is emotionally resonant, visually distinctive, and impossible to stand still to.
